

Edinburgh Airport to Killin

From the airport, get on the A8 (Glasgow Road) to Junction 2 with the M8. Take this North over the Forth Road Bidge and continue to Perth where you change to the A9. This takes you via Dunkeld and Pitlochry to Ballanluig - turn left on to the A827 which goes all the way to Killin. The road follows the 17-mile-long north side of Loch Tay, so that you enter Killin from the opposite direction from Aberdeen or Glasgow routes.

Stay on he main road into he village, passing hotels and guest-houses on your right and a large camping/caravan site on the left. At a small white-painted church, turn left and then immediately right (past an ambulance station and the Coop store and carpark. We are less than 100m further - an entrance with stone pillars and a gate, in trees on your left side. If you reach a small bungalow with a garage, garden shed and various other structures in the garden - you have gone just too far.

Glasgow Airport to Killin

Leaving the airport, look for directions to Sanderling Road, Exit 28, and the M8. Join the M8 heading east - signposted City Centre, Stirling, Edinburgh - change to the M80 and stay on this until the Stirling interchange - take the A84 from here. Stay on the A84 through Doune, Callander, Stratheyre and Lochearnhead, to Lix Toll (petrol station). Turn left here on to the A827 - 3 miles from here to Killin.

Stay on the A827 - it's the only way - through the village. Cross the bridge over the R. Dochart and follow Main Street downhill until you see a small white-painted charch on the right. Turn right just before the church and right again past an ambulance station - we are just 100m or so, on the left, in trees. If you reach a point where there are no trees on your left - you've gone just too far.

Aberdeen to Killin

Heading south from Aberdeen, pick up road A92 for Portlethen and Stonehaven. There is a choice of routes when exiting Stonehaven - stay with the A92 for a coastal road which can be followed all the way to Dundee, if you wish. From Dundee, take the A90 to Perth, then the A85 from Perth to Lix Toll, which is just 3 miles from Killin, on the A827.

Alternative route

Head south out of Aberdeen using either the A90 or A92, as before. From Stonehaven take the A94 which is followed via Brechin and Forfar. At Forfar pick up the A926 to Kirriemuir, Alyth and Blairgowrie. Leave Blairgowrie following signs for Dunkeld and the A9. Take the A9 North to Ballinluig, turning left there on to the A827. This road will lead you Aberfeldy, Loch Tay and **Killin**.
